About the Riverina Touring Network

Project overview

The Riverina Touring Network is a new initiative to develop audiences and build the capacity of venues across the Eastern Riverina region.

Eastern Riverina Arts will work with venues in our service region during 2023 and 2024 to coordinate a series of local performing arts tours.

If you choose to participate, we will support you by:

- Coordinating high-quality tours at manageable cost to participating venues
- Seeking funding and subsidy to support additional tours
- Helping venues develop their own audiences and grow their capabilities
- Testing local demand and appetites for different kinds of performing arts content.

This support is offered free of charge by Eastern Riverina Arts as part of the Riverina Touring Network project. Ultimately, we hope the project will lead to an ongoing sustainable collaboration model for our region.

The Riverina Touring Network is a project led by Eastern Riverina Arts, supported by the NSW Government through Create NSW and the Commonwealth Government through the Regional Arts Fund.

What's in it for you?

Increased buying power. Pool your buying power with other venues in our region to secure fresh performances and bring national names to your audiences.

Artist development. Together we can create a mid-sized touring network that empowers local artists embarking on a 'first tour'. Be part of their story.

Upskill and develop your Venue. Get support to grow your marketing, ticketing and front of house capabilities. Take part in collaborative funding bids

What we want from participating venues

- Commitment to collaborate on programming with 4-6 venues in our region
- Willingness to experiment with various types of shows, new approaches to marketing or front of house, etc.
- Capacity to contribute some funds to secure shows and to negotiate profit-splitting
- Your commitment to local promotions and front-of-house hospitality
- Sharing your audience numbers and assisting Eastern Riverina Arts' efforts to secure funding for tours (eg. letters of support, survey participation)

Funding is secured for this project until the end of 2024. This gives us all a chance to explore what is possible when we collaborate on tours. We hope that over the course of the project we will collectively lay groundwork for a self-sustaining tour network, bringing benefits to our region for years to come.
